



BFNL x MCDNFL Junior Interchange Agreement

This Interchange agreement is for the league's highest Junior grade and below.

An Interchange Agreement between the **Ballarat Football Netball League** and **Maryborough Castlemaine District Football Netball League**.

This agreement is signed pursuant to AFL Victoria Country rules and regulations pertaining to permits and in particular Clause 2.4 –Interchange Agreements, whereby an interchange of players between clubs of the abovementioned Leagues may take place without a transfer and is subject to any provisions contained within this agreement.

PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS APPLY:

1. This agreement is on-going until it is revoked by one of the leagues involved.
2. That the players involved desire to play with the Club on the date(s) requested.
3. That the Clubs involved are agreeable to the players playing on the day in question and have agreed to the permit via PlayHQ.
4. That the players concerned are aware of the AFL VIC regulation 2 - Permits.
5. The Club playing the player from the other League shall show their registered club on the match team sheet.
6. All club registered players must be selected before permit players can receive endorsement to play.
7. Unless otherwise stated in League By-Laws, permit players will not be able to play finals, however if a League's By-Laws do allow this, they may play only one match per day and have satisfied the local League finals eligibility By-Laws. All available registered players must be selected in preference to permit players during finals.
8. Unless otherwise stated in League By-Laws, that the number of players played by any club under this agreement on any one day be restricted to six (6) permit players with a maximum of three (3) coming from any one club.
9. If a club has the following number of their own registered players available of the correct age bracket, the following number of permit players will be the maximum allowed:
 - a. 14 players available on the team sheet: 6 permit players allowed
 - b. 15 players available on the team sheet: 5 permit players allowed
 - c. 16 players available on the team sheet: 4 permit players allowed
 - d. 17 players available on the team sheet: 3 permit players allowed
 - e. 18 players available on the team sheet: 2 permit players allowed
 - f. 19 players available on the team sheet: 1 permit players allowed
 - g. 20 players available on the team sheet: 0 permit players allowed
10. That a player may play two games per weekend but only one game per day under this agreement. A player's registered club has the option to authorise or refuse any permit

application and clubs may only play a player on permit when both clubs have authorised the permit.

11. That a player from any League may play with more than one club from another League but only one match per day.
12. Players playing on permit are not eligible for any League awards.
13. That prior to the commencement of the first match to be played, the players permit club shall submit a request online via PlayHQ. It is the responsibility of the club seeking the permit to have the permit completed by all parties.
14. All permits shall be transacted via PlayHQ using the online permits system. The permit must be completed by all parties prior to the commencement of the game to be played. Any club who does not wish to allow a permit to proceed will need to immediately make contact with their League who will follow up with the necessary contacts.
15. Any club found to have breached the Interchange Agreement and its conditions will be subject to AFL Vic Rule 1.1.
16. Any player reported on permit shall face the independent tribunal of the league in which the alleged offence was committed. Any penalty imposed will apply to all AFL Vic competitions.
17. The Club requesting the permit must also be fully aware of the conditions contained within the Interchange Agreement and any of the local league By-Laws pertaining to the conditions of the Interchange Agreement.
18. For Ballarat FNL affiliated clubs only, players who have participated in an interleague side representing their registered club in the current or previous season are precluded from using this permit.

Local Conditions

Interchange Agreements shall detail any Local conditions relevant to the interchange of players between the two leagues party to the interchange agreement.


