

Senior Netball Development Officer

• The Senior Netball Development Officer is a role within in the netball sub-committee and is responsible for ensuring the competitiveness and professionalism of senior netball teams within the league.

Key Duties include:

- **Talent Development**: Identifying and nurturing talent within senior teams, offering opportunities for player development and progression.
- **Coach Support**: Working with senior coaches to provide leadership, resources, and professional development opportunities.
- **Competition Management**: Ensuring senior netball competitions run smoothly, with consistent rule enforcement and high officiating standards.

Junior Netball Development Officer

• The Junior Netball Development Officer is a role within the netball sub-committee and focuses on the development of junior netball players and competitions.

Key Duties include:

- Development Pathways: Creating and promoting programs that encourage participation in netball from a young age, with clear pathways for progression to senior football. Oversee the junior development program, including the representative teams.
- Volunteer and Coaching Support: Encourage the distribution of resources and training for junior coaches and volunteers, ensuring they are wellequipped to guide young players.
- Player Welfare: Ensuring junior netball programs focus on player welfare, including mental and physical health initiatives and encouraging positive sportsmanship.

Umpire Development Officer

• The Umpire Development Officer is a role within the netball sub-committee and focuses on the development, training, and support of netball umpires.

Key Duties include:

- **Recruitment Initiatives**: Creating and promoting strategies to attract new umpires, focusing on building a sustainable pool of officials for both sports.
- Umpire Training: Coordinating training programs for new and experienced umpires, including accreditation processes (badge testing) and regular skills workshops.
- Netball Victoria: Maintain connection and liaison with Netball Victoria to manage Umpire Tester lists and other essential information about umpire development.
